Ag4Youth is an afterschool program entirely sustained by community donations designed and dedicated to support and assist disadvantaged and at-risk youth of Napa Valley. The program provides a supervised agriculture experience using hands-on techniques of animal husbandry. Ag4Youth participants are required to maintain set academic standards throughout their involvement, with available support from tutors and mentors.

Starting in summer 2023 through fall 2024, Ag4Youth will accept student nominations from educators and community members to be evaluated for acceptance into the program. Unfortunately, there are limited openings and far more children in need than can be accepted; however, the Ag4Youth Board continues to expand the program each year to better meet the community's needs.

Members are expected to attend 1-hour monthly meetings from October – June of each year. Beginning in March, the program gears up and members are expected to visit and work with their animal at the Ag4Youth ranch 3 days/week in the afternoons until the Napa Town & Country Fair concludes in mid-August.
