Ag4Youth is an afterschool program entirely sustained by community donations designed and dedicated to support and assist disadvantaged and at-risk youth of Napa Valley. The transformative program provides a supervised agricultural experience designed to instill responsibility, confidence, and life skills in kids aged 5-19. Through a hands-on approach, participants learn to care for animals, build financial literacy, and learn the value of hard work and collaboration. Ag4Youth participants are required to maintain set academic standards throughout their involvement.

Starting in late summer/early fall 2026, Ag4Youth will accept student nominations from educators and community members to be evaluated for acceptance into the 2026-2027 program.

Members are expected to attend 1-hour monthly meetings from October – June of each year. Beginning in March, the program gears up and members are expected to visit and work with their animal at the Ag4Youth ranch 3 days/week in the afternoons until the Napa Town & Country Fair concludes in mid-August.
